An angiogram is an advanced imaging test that uses X-rays and a contrast dye to map your blood vessels, helping detect blockages or abnormalities in circulation.

Atherectomy is a specialized treatment that removes built-up plaque from the artery walls using a catheter, reducing the risk of serious complications.

Angioplasty

Angioplasty is a minimally invasive procedure where a tiny balloon is used to open narrowed or blocked arteries, restoring healthy blood flow

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IVC

IVC filter placement is a life-saving procedure where a small device is inserted into the inferior vena cava to catch blood clots before they reach the lungs.

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
